

Tuition Costs for the Garrett-Evangelical DMin Program

The Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary Doctor of Ministry Program has automatic scholarships offered to every student accepted into the program. The reason for this is that we will not accept you unless we believe you are worth underwriting.

Note that what are listed below are only the tuition costs. They are not inclusive of housing and other fees. By clicking on the housing application forms you will be able to see the costs associated with taking courses in January and in the summer.

Tuition for School Year 2011-2012 (Runs from July 2011 – June 2012)

Full Tuition Price per Credit Hour	\$720
Automatic 30% Scholarship Deducted	- \$216
Actual Out-of-Pocket Cost per Credit Hour	\$504

Most students take 12 credit hours per year (by taking four 3-credit courses). This means that most students should plan on paying \$6048 in tuition in the coming year (12 credits x \$504/credit = \$6048).

Kellogg Seminar Expenses

Those accepted to the African-American Congregational Leadership track and the Congregational Leadership track take two seminars per year with the Northwestern University Kellogg School of Management. Rather than being charged by semester hour, these two seminars cost a flat fee of \$2500 for both of them.

The total yearly tuition cost for those in the African-American Congregational Leadership track and the Congregational Leadership track, assuming that they are taking 12 credits worth of courses in addition to the two Kellogg seminars, would be \$8548 (12 credits x \$504/credit = \$6048 + \$2500 = \$8548).
