

Tuition Costs for the Garrett-Evangelical DMin Program

The Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary Doctor of Ministry Program has automatic scholarships offered to every student accepted into the program. The reason for this is that we will not accept you unless we believe you are worth underwriting.

The prices below reflect what out-of-pocket tuition costs would be for the student *after* the scholarships are applied.

Note that these are only the tuition costs. They are not inclusive of housing and other fees. Garrett-Evangelical is currently renovating its primary dorm, so the school is working to provide off-campus housing to students as needed. A result of this is that we usually do not have housing costs available until closer to the actual terms when courses are being held. You will be notified prior to arriving what the costs are if you do indicate a need for housing.

Tuition for School Year 2010-2011 (Runs from July 2010 – June 2011)

For this school year *only* there is a significant discount to the first set of courses in each track (taken in October 2010 or in January 2011) in order to encourage applicants to participate in the launching of these new tracks.

Regular price per credit hour: \$453

Discounted price per credit hour: \$260

This leads to the following breakdown for each track in the coming year:

African-American Congregational Leadership Track *and* Congregational Leadership Track

- 15 credits taken (3 credits of Kellogg seminars and 12 credits in coursework at Garrett-Evangelical)
 - 7.5 credits at the inaugural rate
 $7.5 \times \$260 = \1950
 - 7.5 credits at the regular rate
 $7.5 \times \$453 = \3397.50
- Cost for registration and room and board at Kellogg Chicago campus for seminars
 - 2 seminars \times \$500 = \$1000
- Total Cost for the first year: \$6347.50

Spiritual Direction Track

- 12 credits taken (12 credits in coursework at Garrett-Evangelical)
 - 6 credits at the inaugural rate
 $6 \times \$260 = \1560
 - 6 credits at the regular rate
 $6 \times \$453 = \2718
- Total Cost for the year = \$4278
