Fellowships

The seminary will award a select number of fellowships for Master's applicants who display outstanding gifts and graces for ministry and meet the criteria listed below. The fellowship will be for full tuition* at the seminary, and will also cover room (double accommodation) and board (meal plan), or the equivalent for living expenses in a seminary apartment.

Full Tuition Scholarships

The seminary will award a select number of full tuition scholarships* for Master's applicants who meet the criteria listed below. These scholarships will be in the amount of 50% or 75% of tuition.*

Honor Scholarships

The seminary will award a select number of honor scholarships for Master's applicants who meet the criteria below. These scholarships will be in the amount of 50% or 75% of tuition.*

[*Any transfer or advanced standing credit reduces the total required hours. Tuition scholarships cover only these required course hours.]

Eligibility

1. Applicant's must be admitted to a Master's degree program by January 15 of each year with plans to study full-time at the seminary's campus in Evanston, Illinois beginning the fall term after the deadline above.
2. The applicant will submit a statement responding to "**why I should receive a Leadership Award**", which may address intellectual, spiritual and pastoral readiness for graduate level theological study
3. The applicant must be available for an interview with admissions and other personnel. Garrett Evangelical will cover the cost of travel and accommodations during the interview session.

Criteria

1. High academic achievement (3.5 minimum cumulative grade point average for fellowships and full tuition scholarships, 3.0 for honor scholarships).
2. A clear and articulate sense of vocational calling for ministry in the Christian church for while a graduate theological degree is appropriate.
3. Evidence of intellectual ability, emotional maturity, and spiritual readiness to undertake graduate level study in theology.
4. Demonstrated leadership in activities that commend the applicant to his or her calling.
5. Reasonable openness to, and affirmation of, the seminary's educational philosophy and programs.
6. Appropriate gifts and graces for ministry in the Christian church.
7. Evidence of interest in and commitment to ministry in cross-racial, cross-cultural, ecumenical and social justice contexts.
