This lecture is an interactive exploration of a homiletic process for engaging scripture with both the mind and the imagination. The focus is contemporizing and recontextualizing translation of scripture for one's own time and place. The method draws on work done by Cosgrove and his co-author, W. Dow Edgerton, in a recent book, *In Other Words: Incarnational Translation for Preaching* (Eerdmans). Bring a pen or pencil!

Charles H. Cosgrove is the author or editor of nine books and more than thirty-five articles on topics that range from the New Testament to hermeneutics, preaching, congregational studies, law, and music. A professor at Garrett-Evangelical Theological Seminary, he also teaches "Core I" with Dr. Dow Edgerton of Chicago Theological Seminary in the Association of Chicago Theological Schools Doctor of Ministry in Preaching Program.
