

COVID-19 Symptom and Situation Monitoring Questionnaire

All employees should use this questionnaire to monitor themselves for symptoms of COVID-19 each day they intend to come to campus, as well as situations that they may have been in that would potentially place the employee at higher risk of being diagnosed with COVID-19. This will ensure a safe environment for all employees and guide whether an employee should stay home and/or contact their medical professional.

If the answer to all questions is *no*, then the employee is safe to come to campus. If the answer to any question is *yes*, stay home and contact a healthcare provider.

This questionnaire is for your own self-monitoring and does not need to be submitted to anyone on campus.

1. Have you felt sick or feverish in the past 24 hours? (yes/no)
2. Is your temperature below 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit? (yes/no)
3. Have you had any of these symptoms in the past 24 hours? (yes/no)
 - New cough
 - Sore throat
 - Shortness of breath or trouble breathing
 - Headache
 - New body aches or muscle pain
 - New loss of taste or smell
4. Have you had any of these symptoms in the past 24 hours, not related to allergies? (yes/no)
 - Runny nose
 - Stuffy nose
 - Sneezing
5. If you have had runny nose, stuffy nose, or sneezing in the past 24 hours, is it getting worse? (yes/no)
6. Have you traveled outside of the state in the past 14 days? (yes/no)
7. Have you attended a gathering in the last 14 days where social distancing was not observed and/or face masks were not worn.
8. Have you been in close contact with someone with a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19 in the past 14 days? (yes/no)
9. Have you been diagnosed with COVID-19? (yes/no)
10. Will you abide by Garrett-Evangelical's social distancing, hygiene, and face-covering policies while on campus? (yes/no)
